

Things You Need to Know before You Install*

Remove Older Version

We highly recommend that older versions of UTS eXpress IT be removed prior to installation. From the Windows Task Bar, select **Run | Settings | Control Panel | Add or Remove Programs | UTS eXpress IT | Remove**. Note: Any configuration settings for the older version will NOT be deleted, but retained and optionally applied to the new version during the installation.

UTS eXpress IT Installation

The UTS eXpress IT Setup program will present a dialog that will step you through the installation process. We recommend that you take the defaults whenever possible. Please use the following procedure:

1. Insert the UTS eXpress IT CD in your disk drive. The setup process should begin automatically.
2. Follow the instructions on the screen when presented.

If you have downloaded a version from our Web or FTP site, you will need to place all the files in a single temporary directory and run UTSeXpressIT.exe.

UTS eXpress IT Configuration

When you first execute UTS eXpress IT, it will take you directly to the configuration dialogs where you can configure your first host connection and setup a screen to use that connection. Later, you may configure additional connections/screens with the following procedure:

1. Run the **UTS eXpress IT** program/icon.
2. Click the **Configure UTS eXpress IT** button on the UTS eXpress IT Control Panel.
3. Press the **Configure** button.
4. From the **eXpress Connect Visual Configuration** window, you may add, edit, duplicate and delete routes, open ids and virtual destinations with the buttons and menu selections provided.
